Commencement Contingency Information for Inclement Weather

Baccalaureate Mass will be held in the Mirenda Center on Friday, May 12, at 7 p.m.

Neumann University will hold its Commencement Exercises on the South Lawn of the Aston campus on Saturday, May 13, at 12:30 p.m., weather permitting.

In the event of severe or stormy weather (including thunder, lightning and/or high winds) Commencement Exercises will be moved to the Mirenda Center for Sport, Spirituality and Character Development.

If Commencement Exercises are to be relocated, we will attempt to make the announcement by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday. Please check the website or your Neumann e-mail.

Students will not process. Instead, they will be directed to their seats.

The Sisters of Saint Francis of Philadelphia will distribute Tau crosses to the students as they are being seated.

Faculty will be invited to line up and robe in the Student Lounge area of the lower level of the Mirenda Center.

Commencement Exercises will begin at 12:30 p.m. The members of the President's platform party will process into the Mirenda Center followed by faculty.

Board members will be seated in the first row followed by faculty, students, family and friends, in that order.

Those guests who do not have inclement weather tickets will be directed to one of three overflow locations, where they will be able to view Commencement Exercises via live video feed: The Meagher Theatre, Bruder Student Multipurpose Hall and the Bruder Gymnasium of the Bruder Life Center. The ceremony will also be streamed to digital signage throughout the University.
