

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. Part I of this form must be completed and uploaded by applicants who are not U.S. citizens or U.S. permanent residents. The data provided in this form assists Neumann University in maintaining records of admitted and enrolled students. Students requesting a Certificate of Eligibility Form I-20 for F-1 status must complete Parts I and II of this form. United States federal regulations require certification that you have sufficient funds to pay for your tuition and living expenses at Neumann University for the duration of your studies. A Form I-20 can be issued only after this certificate and proof of financial support has been received. A copy of the identification page of the passport you will use to enter the U.S. is also required. Students already in F-1 status at another U.S. school must also submit a Financial Certificate and supporting documentation to be issued an I-20 from Neumann.

Once completed, you should submit your Financial Certificate and supporting documents by uploading them to the I-20 Request form.
