Your 2026-27 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected by the U.S. Department of Education for a review process called verification. Institutions are mandated by Title IV (federal) regulations to verify FAFSA information. Verification must be completed to meet disbursement eligibility for some financial aid programs.

To complete the verification process for your FAFSA you must confirm your identity by presenting in person a **valid, unexpired, government-issued photo identification** (ID) such as a passport, a driver's license, or other state-issued ID. "Unexpired" means the ID has not expired at the time it is checked, even if it will expire before the end of the award year. A valid government-issued photo identification is one issued by the U.S. government, any of the 50 States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, a federally recognized American Indian and Alaska Native Tribe, American Samoa, Guam, the Virgin Islands, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau.

If Neumann University determines that you are unable to appear in person to present an unexpired, valid, government-issued photo identification, you have the option of appearing on a video call to present an unexpired, valid, government-issued photo identification to an institutionally authorized individual who will review the identification. You can still, but are not required to, submit a copy of your identification document that is acknowledged in a notary statement or that is presented to a notary.
